PRE-PROFESSIONAL DIVISION

Ages 8 & up. Students are required to take two ballet classes per week.

Ballet I-V & Pointe

Beginning with Level I, students will learn classical ballet technique with an awareness of alignment & discipline enabling them to progress to higher levels. Mastery of skill set is assessed by the instructor & determines class placement.

Modern Dance

These classes embody free & expressive movement, not bound to ballet stipulations. Various styles will be incorporated.

Jazz

Beginning & intermediate levels focus on rhythm & technique while advanced levels will integrate contemporary styles.
